THE CONSTITUTION

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PREAMBLE:

This is a sub organization of the United Nation (UN) Economic and Social Council Accredited (ECOSOC). This organization is aimed at helping the society in infrastructural development, easing poverty of the people by giving Scholarships, training people in handy works, giving medical assistance, feeding of widows and orphans.

This Constitution shall be the supreme law of Global Alliance Management Institute of Ghana and any other law found to be inconsistent with any provision of this Constitution shall, to the extent of the inconsistency, be void.

ARTICLE 1: NAME

The name of the organization will be **GLOBAL ALLIANCE INSTITUTE GHANA**, hereafter referred to as **GAMIG**.

ARTICLE 2: OBJECTIVES

The objectives of **GLOBAL ALLIANCE MANAGEMENT GHANA** shall be to:

- Do our best to assist any emergency situations in Africa and the world at large.
- Give medical assistance to grown-ups 60years and above.
- Provide educational assistance to intelligent but needy children.
- Provide ADR service and consultation to the general public.
- Prosper the community in which we live in.
- Donate to where ever we the members of the NGO will decide. Example.
Prisons, Hospitals, Children's Homes, Widows etc.
- Provide skills and training periodically and certificate will be given.
- Support any affected member in case of marriage, funeral (spouse, mom, and dad).
- A member can propose a project to be funded by GAMIG in their area.

ARTICLE 3: FINANCE

- a. The income and property of **GLOBAL ALLIANCE MANAGEMENT GHANA** howsoever derived shall be applied solely towards the promotion of the objectives of GAMIG as set forth in the immediately preceding articles, no portion thereof shall be paid or transferred, directly or indirectly by way of dividend, bonus or profit to any person who is a Patron, Trustee or member of the Board of Directors.
- b. Nothing herein contained shall prevent the payment in good faith, of reasonable and proper remuneration to any Patron, Trustee or member of the GAMIG Board in return for any services actually rendered to GAMIG nor prevent payment on interest at a rate not exceeding six (6) percent per annum on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent for premises let to GAMIG.
- c. No Patron, Trustee or member of GAMIG shall be appointed to any salaried office of GAMIG or an office of GAMIG payable by fees.

- d. No remuneration or other benefit in money's worth shall be given by GAMIG to any Patron, Trustee, Board Member or Executive except repayment of out-of-pocket expenses or interest of a rate aforesaid on money lent or reasonable and proper rent for premises let to GAMIG.
- e. Funds of GAMIG shall be derived from the following sources:
 - ❖ Donations.
 - ❖ Dues and subscription of the board and members.
 - ❖ Grants from external donors.
 - ❖ Accretions and other legal forms of acquisitions.
 - ❖ Other sources of legitimate funding.
- f. The funds of GAMIG shall be deposited at a recognized Commercial Bank agreed upon by the Board of Directors. GAMIG shall operate Savings and Current accounts as well as a local and foreign Account. There shall be three signatories of which the President and any others as shall be agreed by the Board shall be co-signatories.

ARTICLE 4: AUDITOR

- a. The accounts of GAMIG shall be audited annually by an accredited independent Auditing Firm to be determined by the Board.
- b. GAMIG shall keep proper books and records of accounts and this will be kept at its registered office, together with records of names and addresses of its members articulated to vote.

ARTICLE 5: MEMBERSHIP

- a. Subscribers of these regulations and such other persons as the Board of Directors or Executive shall admit to membership shall be members of GAMIG.
- b. The Executive members in a general meeting may by ordinary resolution prescribe qualifications for membership of GAMIG and unless the resolution otherwise provides, no person shall thereafter be admitted to membership by the Board of Directors unless he has the prescribed qualifications.
- c. GAMIG, General meeting may resolve by ordinary resolution that the Board may admit to honorary membership of GAMIG, any person, whether or not an ordinary or associate member of GAMIG who in the opinion of the Board has rendered special service to GAMIG or to any of the objectives which GAMIG was formed to promote.
- d. An honorary member, unless also admitted as an ordinary member, shall have the same rights as an associate member, and if also admitted as an ordinary member shall have the same rights as an ordinary member but shall not be liable to pay any subscription to GAMIG.
- e. MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES:

Membership Cards shall be in 3 categories, that is

- ❖ **Silver**
- ❖ **Gold**
- ❖ **Platinum**

The cards have been categorized according to your performance in support of the aims and the vision of the organization. The cards are given based on regular payment of dues, your availability on meeting days, your effort of being a peace maker and socialist leader in your community, your willingness in support of eliminating poverty in your community. Any of these cards comes with rewards and benefits. The good news is that every registered member of the organization automatically becomes a silver card member. This card will be renewed every two years. And within the two years the president and the executive members of this organization will follow your activities towards the growth of the organization closely that at the time of renewal they will reward base on your performance to become either a gold card holder or a platinum card holder.

TO BECOME A GOLD CARD HOLDER

One must be active for two years and should be productive.

BENEFITS OF A GOLD CARD HOLDER

- ❖ A memorial project will be done in your community.
- ❖ You will be selected as a representative of the NGO in your community

TO BECOME A PLATINUM CARD HOLDER

Someone who has been a gold card holder for three years with good conduct and has been professional and productive will become a platinum card holder.

BENEFITS OF THE PLATINUM CARD HOLDER

- ❖ A platinum card holder shall be selected to represent the organization in the UN-ECOSOC meeting annually with visa free
- ❖ A memorial project will be done in your community.

ARTICLE 6: EXCLUSION OF MEMBERS

Subject, in case of ordinary members, in compliance with section (1) of the companies' code 1963 (ACT 79)

- a. Any ordinary, associate or honorary member may resign his/her membership by notice in writing to the Executive council.
- b. The Executive council with the advice from the advisory Board may in its discretion exclude from membership of GAMIG any ordinary or honorary member if:

- The subscription payable to GAMIG by such ordinary or associate member shall be unpaid six months after the same shall have become due and payable or
- In the opinion of the Executive council and advisory Board the continued membership of such person would be detrimental to the interest of GAMIG or to the furtherance of its objectives.

ARTICLE 7: VOTES OF MEMBERS

Each ordinary member present at any general meeting shall have one vote on a show of hands or a poll and if a postal ballot is directed in accordance with an article thereof, each ordinary member whether present or not at a meeting shall have one vote.

ARTICLE 8: GOVERNANCE

For the proper management of the affairs of GAMIC, there shall be:

A. National Executive Council

A (1) The Executive council shall be responsible for formulating GAMIC policy and overseeing the implementation of the same.

A (2) The national executive positions of the organization shall be as follows:

1. The Chairman
2. General Secretary
3. Assistant Secretary
4. Coordinator
5. Organizer
6. There shall be two persons appointed as advisers to the Executive Council

A (3) Any vacancy occurring in these offices shall be filled in like manner at the next meeting of the executive of the vacancy.

B. MODE OF ELECTION

All Executive positions except that of the advisers shall be by nomination among standing members and subsequent election of the nominees by all card bearing members.

Election is won by simple majority of all valid votes cast.

C. INTERIM LEADERS

- ❖ In the interim, the patron and founder of this organization shall in consultation with members, appoint five member panel of executives to serve

as executives for the first two (2) years. Members of the panel have a one year renewable term.

There shall be two persons appointed by the panel as in clause 8(A) above to serve as advisors of the interim leaders.

The Founder shall be a non-voting member of the Interim Leadership.

- ❖ Interim leaders shall as in clause 8(c) above be appointed to oversee the activities of newly established branches of the GAMIG until substantive leaders are nominated and elected as in clause 8(B) above. The makeup of branch interim leadership shall not be more than 3 persons.

D. ADVISORY BOARD

There shall be an advisory board to supervise the workings of the Executive Council. The Advisory Board shall constitute the Founder, The Chairman, The General Secretary and one other member of the Executive council in addition to not less than two (2) but not more than four (4) other persons appointed by the founder.

Advisory board meetings shall be organized quarterly to advise and scrutinize the activities of the executive council. Special Emergency meetings can be called when the need arises.

E. BRANCHES

- a. Branches of the organization shall be set up in consultation with the national executives and the national advisory board.
- b. Branches shall be governed by not more than 3 executives
- c. Branch executives shall include, The branch Chairman, The branch Secretary and the branch Organizer.
- d. All activities and workings of the Branch and its executives shall be under the supervision of the National Executives.
- e. Branch executive positions shall be by nominations and subsequently nominees shall be voted for, by all branch members. Winning of election shall be by simple majority of valid votes cast.
- f. Election of branch executives shall be supervised by national Executives.

F. GENERAL ASSEMBLY

- a. The general assembly shall constitute all members of the advisory board, national executives and all branch Executives.

- b. The general assembly shall meet twice every year

- c. At the general assembly meeting, all branches must submit through their executives a report of all activities undertaken at the various branches.

- d. The founder of the organization shall chair the general assembly meetings.

- e. In the absence of the Founder, the general assembly meeting shall be chaired by a member of the assembly appointed by the founder to act in his stead.

- f. Extraordinary General Assembly Meetings may be convened by the Board whenever they think fit.

ARTICLE 9. PRESS AND MEDIA BRIEFINGS.

The executives shall in consultation with the advisory board release press statements of national issues as well as any other issue pertaining to this organization

ARTICLE 10. DUES AND FUNDS

- a. To pick a membership form, a specified amount shall be paid.
- b. Monthly dues of a specific amount of money shall be paid by every member of the organization.
- c. The amount of money to be paid as in 10(a) and 10(b) shall be determined by the Executive council and shall be reviewed yearly by the executives
- d. At the end of every year all members of the GAMIC will meet at the headquarters (Gbawe Top Base) and raise funds in support of the aim and vision of the organization.
- e. Free will donations is also acceptable from willing members

ARTICLE 11: AMENDMENTS

- a. Amendments to this constitution must be approved by a simple two-thirds majority of members present and voting at a general meeting of the project.

- b. Notice of intention to move such an amendment must be given to the Executives and Advisory Board at least 30 days prior to the date of such meeting.

- c. Copy of such intended amendments shall be circulated to members 21 days prior to the date of such meeting.

ARTICLE 12: DISSOLUTION

- a. Each member of GAMIG undertakes to contribute to the assets of GAMIG in the event of its being wound up while he/she is a member or within one year after he/she ceases to be a member, for the payment of debts and liabilities of GAMIG and of the cost of winding up such amount as may be required not exceeding One Hundred Ghana Cedis (GH¢100).
- b. If upon the winding up or dissolution of GAMIG, there remains after the discharge of its debts, liabilities and property of the project, the same shall not be distributed among members but shall be transferred to some other Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) or charity limited by guarantee having objects similar to the objects of GAMIG or applied to some charitable object, such other organization or charity to be determined by ordinary resolution of members at a general meeting prior to the dissolution of GAMIG
